



Families Outreach Ministry

(part time 20-30 hours per week)

Role Description

This position (20-30hrs per week – Friday/ Sunday and other days in discussion with the successful applicant) would be responsible for building bridges and connecting with the preschool, school, and wider community. To do this will require equipping current church members, and discipling families.

There will be responsibilities to lead teams to run a playgroup style ministry, and developing a coffee based drop off group for preschool parents. There will also be involvement in existing kid's ministries, with the goal of building relationships with families. Time will be given to organise various seminars or courses (eg parenting seminar, marriage course, Christianity Explored, etc).
